



YOU ARE SAFE ON YELON







We started the Yelon (You ark not aLONe) program so that you are not alone with your questions. If you are interested in issues related to your body, soul, love, health, sexuality, or want to learn about your rights, you can find reliable information on yelon.hu, without taboos. If you'd like, you can chat with us anonymously and free of charge. The website also has a section for adults with articles on parenting.

How do we assure that yelon.hu is a safe place?

The editors of Yelon pay special attention to ensure that the information on the site is trustworthy and that you can browse safely.

- Our youngest viewers are 10-year-old children. When we write an article or choose a picture to share on Yelon we always take their interests into account as well.
- We recognise that many of us think in many different ways. We respect every child's way of thinking.
- We choose our words with caution so that it does not hurt anyone.
- We take care to ensure that no article is frightening. Our aim is
 to provide necessary and closely related information on the topic
 in question. Topics related to physicality, nudity and sexuality
 are also presented in this form and extent.

- - Every article starts with general information and then goes into details. We do this so you can stop reading the article at any time if it becomes uncomfortable for you.
 - If you open an article, we always warn you if there are photos which may be sensitive or which may affect you (for example, a graphic of genitals).
 - Every article is reviewed by two adults and at least two students aged 14-18.
 - We don't use photos or videos in which there are recognisable children (or young adults who look like children under 18). For more details click here.
 - We pay attention not to link any source (for example, source of a photo) that may endanger the safety of children.
 - The www.yelon.hu/szuloknek page has to be in line with content created for children and with our policy.

What do we do to ensure that the Yelon chat is a safe place?

- We choose our chat operators in multiple rounds of interviews and we train them. Afterwards they regularly attend professional trainings.
- The chat operators can only respond from the Foundation's office. A supervisor is always present to help out a colleague if it is necessary.
- They sign an obligation of confidentiality, and cannot share any information that children tell them on the Yelon chat.

Where can you report being harmed or hurt on the Yelon chat?

How do we protect your data?

- The Yelon chat operates on a secure interface in accordance with laws and regulations. Only the Yelon chat operators (no other colleagues at the Foundation) have access to this platform.
- The chat operators can only chat from the Foundation's office at a specified time on secured computers.
- We do not store any personal data about children.
- The closed conversations are permanently deleted from our servers after 60 days. They won't be accessible afterwards.
